New techno festival Rabid comes to London

THINK THAT the festival season is over come the end of summer? Think again. The Rabid Festival is heading to London and will have us foaming at the mouth with the hottest underground names in techno.

Taking place at London's renowned club cavern SeOne, in London Bridge, on 7th November, Rabid is the brainchild of Mexican promoter Christopher Ruvalcaba Carrascal, who has dreamed of bringing his own techno event to the capital for years. "I've been putting on shows in Mexico for many years," he told DJmag. "From live shows like Underworld to DJs like Richie Hawtin, Steve Bug and Moby, and a bunch of festivals.

"My brother lives in London and for many years we've thought about doing this festival. It's the beginning of many events we're going to put on in London."

DJmag will be there, hosting our own stage, with four other stages curated by a clutch of the best club nights in

town, including Wet Yourself and Trailer Trash. Naturally, the coolest names in the tech fraternity will be performing — Slovenian electronic king Umek heads the bill alongside Moon Harbour main man Matthias Tanzmann (pictured left), rising tech don Paul Ritch plays live and Andre Kraml, Martin Czubala, Hannah Holland and Silver Surfer will be turning the party out.

"It looks good to me!" enthused Tanzmann of the Rabid Festival. "I'll be playing on the electronic, groovy house tip. I use more classic house beats nowadays, nice grooves and organic sounds. I've just finished a couple of tracks with Martinez from Paris, and I'll definitely be playing those."
