ENGLISH:

Champagne or water – which one is more suitable for a small label jubilee? Well, probably it's best to celebrate such an event with a superb release. After the highly appreciated compilation "Moon Harbour Inhouse Vol. 2", Moon Harbour throws in 12inch number 30 by its very own Mario "Marlow" Weise. Alongside label founder Matthias Tanzmann he has been part of the Moon Harbour family right from its start, having had two veritable hits during the last two years with "Movin" and "Quiet", both together with singer Dehlia/Franziska Grohmann.

His new track "Water" (b2) breathes fresh air into the almost forgotten genre of Deep House. Organic Elements meet detailed sound work and subtle pop appeal. With singer Claudia Nehls at the mic, warm chords, handmade bass and a surprising guest appearance of the flute "Water" is the perfect companion for the sweet melancholy of early summer days.

Daniel Stefanik's remix is much more floor-oriented and absolutely worth a full-length a-side. Hypnotically reduced with a fascinating dynamic, his work refers to key elements of the original, wrapping them up in a euphoric climax. Once more Moon Harbour's youngest ambassador shows his excellent producing capabilities with his fusion of Minimal, House and feastful Detroit harmonies.

Jackmate (b1) puts more emphasis on the dark aspects in the original, slowly evolving to a very condensed climax. Reminiscent of Carl Craig remix works, the bassline is somewhat of a guide through the whole track, embracing everything as it seems.

If the celebration of a jubilee can look like this, water just does perfect.

DEUTSCH:

Sekt oder Selters? Wie feiert ein Label angemessen ein kleines Jubiläum? Am besten mit einem superben Release aus den eigenen Reihen. Nach der viel gelobten Compilation „Moon Harbour Inhouse Vol. 2“ folgt nun die 12“ No. 30. Und wer könnte für diesen Anlass prädestinierter sein als Mario »Marlow« Weise. Neben dem Label-Begründer Matthias Tanzmann gehört er von Anfang an zur Moon Harbour-Familie und mit „Movin“ sowie „Quiet“ sind dem sympathisch entspannten Leipziger Producer innerhalb der letzten beiden Jahre zwei veritable Hits, zusammen mit der Sängerin Dehlia (Franziska Grohmann), gelungen.

Marlows neuer Track „Water“ (b2) revitalisiert die beinahe ins Vergessene geratene Leichtigkeit von Deep House und verbindet organische Elemente mit feingliedrig umherschwirrenden Sounds und einem subtilen Pop-Appeal. Mit der Sängerin Claudia Nehls am Mikrophon, den warmen Chords, dem live eingespielten Bass und der plötzlich umher tänzelnden Flöte begleitet „Water“ die süße Melancholie der ersten frühsummerlichen Tage.

Direkter auf die späteren Stunden des Dancefloors schießt Daniel Stefanik mit einem Remix, der es wahrlich verdient, die gesamte A-Seite für sich zu beanspruchen. Hypnotisch reduziert, in einer faszinierend klaren Dynamik beginnt der Track, streut dezent die wesentlichen Marlow-Essenzen ein und mündet in einen euphorischen Exkurs, um anschließend nochmals zu dem minimalistischen Ausgangspunkt zurückzukehren. Moon Harbours jüngster Spross zeigt einmal mehr seine herausragenden Producer-Fähigkeiten und verknüpft ganz nebenbei Minimal, schwelgerische Detroit-Harmonien und House in einem Stück.

Jackmate (b1) betont hingegen die düstere Seite des Originals stärker und führt den Track auf behutsame, aber konsequente Weise zu einem dichten Höhepunkt, ohne die anfängliche Eleganz zu verlieren. Wie ein roter Faden zieht sich eine eindringliche Bassline, welche ein wenig an Carl Craigs Remixe erinnert, durch das gesamte Stück des Stuttgarters und wirkt wie ein alles umarmendes Band, das nach einem kleinen Höhenflug sanft aufzufangen weiß.

Wenn ein Jubiläum so freudig gefeiert werden kann, dann reicht auch Selters aka „Water“..

Moon Harbour are on absolute fire at the moment and have carved out a definite niche for themselves pioneering a cutting edge deep House sound that takes influence from both classic Detroit and modern minimalism but always sounding fresh. Daniel Stefanik's remix of water goes down a dubby, organic route beautifully incorporating Claudia Nehls magical vocal and ends up in a flurry of Detroit stabs. Jackmate's remix definitely references Carl Craig in his intense, dramatic building version. Last up the original is here with its syncopated, soft beats, natural bass and flute solo. Exquisite!
